Shelford & District Bridleways Group (SDBG) Permissive Bridleway Tracks

As a member of the Group, you are entitled to use SDBG permissive tracks as and when they can be agreed with landowners. This entitlement is subject to the following conditions which will become part of the application to join SDBG and may be amended at any time by notification to members. Details of the permissive tracks will be posted on the SDBG website.

1. Signed acceptance of these conditions.

I agree to abide by the above conditions.

- 2. The countryside code is to be observed and no damage caused to the property.
- 3. Permission is granted for you to ride on horseback, walk or cycle within the limits of the tracks.
- 4. Anyone using the tracks must treat other users with courtesy and consideration. Cyclists must give way to horses and pedestrians
- 5. Access is only permitted during the hours of daylight and may be withdrawn from time to time for land management, farm work, ground conditions, maintenance and safety reasons. Track closure will be indicated by signs.
- Dogs must remain under control, on a lead and within the limit of the tracks at all times. Disturbance of wildlife during the breeding season should be avoided. Dog walkers should remove any mess left by their dog.
- 7. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult
- 8. Users must report any damage or problem with the tracks to Shelford & District Bridleways Group immediately
- 9. Neither the landowners nor SDBG will entertain any third party claims. Access is entirely at your own risk
- 10. Shelford and District Bridleways Group retain the right to withdraw this permission in its entirety at any time without notice.

Please ensure that you carry your SDBG membership tag with you when you access the tracks as you may be required to show proof of membership.
